USS Cobia Submarine & Wisconsin Maritime Museum on Oct. 1-2, 2022**

Troops 427 will visit a fish processing facility followed by fishing for big, lake-run salmon. We'll spend Saturday night on the USS Cobia submarine, stationed in Manitowoc and we'll spend some time Sunday morning in the Wisconsin Maritime Museum. The cost of \$60 per participant will cover USS Cobia fee and Saturday Dinner & Sunday Breakfast Lunch Saturday and Sunday (depending on return time) would be on individual basis and scouts would be responsible for bringing some spending money to buy their lunches.

Arrive by 7:45am at the St. Anne parking lot on Sat. morning Oct. 1 for a departure at 8am for the Fish Facility in Kewaunee. Scouts should have eaten before they arrive. Scouts need to wear Class A uniform for travel on Sat. & Sun. Packing recommendations will follow. Scouts age 16 and older who intend to fish, need a valid Wisconsin fishing license with Great Lakes salmon stamp. 2-day fishing licenses with salmon stamp are available for \$14, should be purchased in advance by each scout.

We can only have 25 participants for this event. We will take reservation as you hand in the troop permission slip. Don't delay handing this form in to reserve your spot.
