Scouts need to wear Class A uniform for travel on Fri. & Sun. Packing recommendations will follow. We will be sleeping in tents. Bring layers of clothes and a water bottle for the hikes. We recommend moisture wicking socks, sturdy shoes or hiking boots, rain gear and a small daypack for hiking. Registration also includes admission to the family dance on Saturday evening. Total cost for the weekend event will be \$40 for Scouts and Adult Leaders which includes food & transportation, park sticker (for vehicles that need one) & registration fee.
