

## Logistics for 2024 Summer Camp at Camp Tesomas Iroquois Campsite

St. Anne our Charter has their 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary Mass at 10:00am on Sunday June 16<sup>th</sup>. For those that would like to attend the Mass we are asking that you wear your Scout Uniform. The new Bishop of the LaCrosse Diocese will officiate the Mass. So, we are now moving back our meeting time to go to Camp Tesomas on **Sunday, June 16<sup>th</sup> to 12:00pm**, all scouts and Adult Leaders participating in Week 1 of summer camp need to meet at **Newman Catholic High School**. As usual, wear your Class A uniform for travel. You will, however, receive your summer camp t-shirt upon arrival at Newman and have the option to wear that to camp in lieu of your Class A uniform. Please bring a sack lunch to eat enroute to Camp Tesomas. Our first meal at camp will be Sunday supper. Please note, we are not bringing bikes to camp until Week 2, so please do not bring your bike with you this Sunday. Vehicles with trailers will go directly to the Iroquois Campsite and all other vehicles will park in the Hanna Parking Lot which is close to our campsite.

Scouts will be dismissed from Week 1 on **Friday, June 21<sup>st</sup> at 7 pm** at **Hannah Venture Base**. Parents are welcome to pick up scouts directly from Summer Camp Iroquois Campsite on Friday, but please have your scout inform Mr. Pease or Mr. Klement that they are leaving. Scouts may return to Wausau with adult leaders (please mark on the form), but parents should make arrangements to promptly pick up scouts upon our return to Wausau. Meeting place on Friday evening, unless advised otherwise, will be Newman High School.

On **Sunday, June 23<sup>rd</sup> at 10:30 am**, all scouts participating in Week 2 of summer camp need to meet at **Newman Catholic High School**. Once again, you may wear your Class A uniform or 2021 summer camp t-shirt for travel. Once again, please bring a sack lunch to eat on the way to camp. Also, if you want to have a bicycle to use for Week 2 of summer camp (highly recommended), please bring it with you. Make sure your tires are properly inflated, your brakes are functional, and your bike is otherwise in good working condition.

Family visit on **Wednesday June 26<sup>th</sup>** with visitation from 3:30pm, dinner 5-6:30 followed by OA Ceremony. Family Visit form on the Troop website due June 11<sup>th</sup>, 2024.

On **Saturday, June 29<sup>th</sup>**, we will meet at **St. Anne's** to return troop gear to storage. Our **estimated time of arrival is 10 am**, but that is subject to change depending on how quickly we are able to break camp and check out with Camp Tesomas personnel. We know many families have plans for the weekend and will be anxious to have their scouts join them. However, it is a big job putting away two weeks' worth of troop gear, and it is important that all scouts help with that task. Remember, a scout is helpful.
